CUT FLOWERS (BENCH CLASS)

Roses 2/3 to 3/4 open; own foliage; side buds removed, vases provided. Please name variety if possible.

- _____ 1. One Peace, Pink Peace, or Chicago Peace
- _____ 2. One Pink Rose
- _____ 3. One Yellow or Apricot Rose
- _____ 4. One Bi-Coloured Rose
- _____ 5. One Red Rose

The following classes require your own containers

- _____ 6. A single fragrant rose in a bowl covered with plastic wrap to hold its scent.
- _____ 7. A container of miniature roses; may be mixed colours; with own foliage.
- _____ 8. Clematis, 1 bloom any colour, own foliage.
- _____ 9. Bearded Iris, one stem, any colour.
- _____ 10. Siberian Iris, one stem, any colour.
- _____ 11. Daisies, 5 stems, same variety, with own foliage.
- _____ 12. Bowl of pansies, three blooms, may be mixed colours, with own foliage, floating on water.
- _____ 13. Columbine, three stems, may be mixed colours.
- _____ 14. Flowering branch with a woody stem, no more than 25 inches (63.5 cm) tall.
- _____ 15. Three Hosta leaves, any variety, 4-9 inches (10-23 cm) wide, 7-13 inches (18-33 cm) in length.
- _____ 16. Open class – Any flower of single type not listed above, one to three stems with or without foliage.

FLORAL ART CLASS

- _____ 17. **Tea-Time** – an arrangement in a fancy teacup and saucer. Flowers may be purchased.
- _____ 18. **Oriental Inspiration** - an arrangement of three flowers, oriental style, with any kind of foliage. Accessories permitted, flowers may be purchased.
- _____ 19. **It's Play Time**- A floral display incorporating a child's toy or toys. Accessories permitted.
- _____ 20. **Shades of a Colour** – A monochromatic exhibit in shades of **Purple**, with greenery. Flowers may be purchased but not dyed, container must match.
- _____ 21. **Teeny-Tiny wonder** - a miniature exhibit not more than 3 inches (9.6 cm) in any direction, including container.
- _____ 22. **Name that Song** - An arrangement based on a song. Accessories permitted. Please name the song.

- _____ 23. ***Yum-Yum!*** - an arrangement of early edibles from your garden such as herbs, vegetables; garnished with flowers; arranged on a plate no larger than 10 inches (25 cm) in any direction.

POTTED PLANT/NOVELTY CLASS

- _____ 24. ***Fairy Garden*** in a container, no larger than 6 inches (15 cm) in any direction, accessories permitted.
- _____ 25. ***“Might be Prickly”*** An assortment of cacti and/or succulents, any kind of container, no larger than 10 inches (25 cm) in any direction.
- _____ 26. ***Terrarium garden*** – no larger than 10 inches (25 cm) in any direction, containing 3 to 5 small plants.
- _____ 27. ***A Favorite House Plant*** – that you have owned for more than 6 months.
- _____ 28. ***Orchid*** – a single potted variety you have owned for more than 6 months.

PHOTOGRAPHY (non-judged)

- _____ 29. ***Creatures in your Garden*** – A photograph of a “creature” or “creatures” in your garden.
- _____ 30. ***Favourite tree*** - A photograph of your favourite tree in bloom.
